

How do I change a takeoff from one condition to another? (Reassign Objects feature)

Let's take for example that you created a condition and did some takeoff with it. After some time the Owner/Architect makes a change to the original plans and has changed some of the takeoff to a different condition. In previous versions of our software you could not take a segment or area of takeoff and change what condition it was tied to. We now have added the ability to reassign takeoff to a different condition. This FAQ will explain that process.

1. Find the area(s) or segment(s) of takeoff you wish to reassign to a different condition and select them.
2. They will now be highlighted in a different color (default is orange). This indicates that they are selected.
3. With the takeoff selected, take your select arrow and select the condition you to wish to reassign it to. Right click on this condition and click on 'Reassign Objects'. Say 'Yes' to the dialog box that appears and the selected takeoff will then now be assigned to the condition you reassigned it to.

Note: This can be helpful if you have 2 conditions occupying the same footprint or linear lines. For example if you had an acoustical ceiling you had taken off that follows the same perimeter as the VCT tile you wish to install on the floor you can copy the acoustical ceiling takeoff, paste it and then reassign the pasted takeoff as VCT Tile.
